

MEETING SUMMARY (February 28, 2006)

On February 28, 2006, the Mecklenburg-Union Metropolitan Planning Organization's staff in conjunction with the Town of Indian Trail, Town of Stallings, Union County, Town of Weddington, and NCDOT hosted a public meeting to provide an update on the status of the Chestnut Lane project.

The meeting was held at Antioch Elementary School from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. More than 4,000 meeting notices were mailed to citizens within the study area boundary and approximately fifty-seven individuals attended the meeting.

As citizens arrived they were directed to sign-in and given a packet of information to review at their leisure. Individuals were informed that the meeting was design as a drop-in session, informal and that a formal presentation would not be given. However, each person could view maps and visit any of three workstations manned by staff to view additional maps and ask questions.

PROJECT STATUS

Currently an assessment of the traffic volume and vehicle turning movement data is near completion. The data will be used to help determine which alignment option or options are most desirable to meet potential future vehicle demand needs.
