

**Stallings Road
TIP #U-3825**

Project Summary: Stallings Road (SR 1365) is proposed to be widened from its current two-lane cross-section to multi-lanes from Old Monroe Road to US Hwy 74. The need for the project is to increase the road's traffic-carrying capacity and to improve safety. This section of Stallings Road has an accident rate approximately 30% higher than the statewide average for roadways of this type.

This project is funded in the North Carolina Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Construction is scheduled to begin in fiscal year 2011.

Estimated Project Cost: \$ 8,917,000

Average Daily Traffic: Existing: 11,000 vehicles per day
Projected by 2030: 16,000 vehicles per day
